In most cases, your household must meet both the gross and net income limits described below or you are not eligible for SNAP and cannot receive benefits. Gross income means a household's total, non-excluded income, before any deductions have been made. Net income means gross income minus allowable deductions.

The answer is yes. BAH income is typically counted towards your gross income when determining if you are eligible for food stamps. As such, your GI Bill benefits do contribute to your income, even though that income is temporary and not taxed.

Non-financial requirements include state residency, citizenship/alien status, work registration and cooperation with the IMPACT (job training) program. Financial criteria include income and asset limits. The asset/resource limits are \$5,000 for most households. Assets include bank accounts, cash, real estate....

Some people who have little or no money may qualify for Expedited Food Supplement benefits right away. They must have only an interview and verify identity.

Applying for Nutrition Assistance (Formerly the Food Stamp ...

There is no gross income limit, no net income limit and no asset limit. Net monthly income must be 100 percent or less of the Federal poverty guidelines. Net income is figured by adding all of a household's gross income, and then taking a number of approved deductions for child care, extra shelter costs and other expenses.

People also can buy garden seeds with SNAP benefits. SNAP food benefits are put on to the Lone Star Card and can be used just like a credit card at any store that accepts SNAP. SNAP can't be used to: Buy tobacco. Buy alcoholic drinks. Buy things you can't eat or drink. Pay for food bills you owe.
