Now it is time to remove the intake, take the 2 bolts out of the egr cooler at the front of the intake (deep well 10mm socket) and remove the clamp that holds the egr cooler to the up pipe. I just cut the small blue/orange hose that connects the egr cooler to the oilcooler with a knife.

What happened is the oil seeped in, and when mixed with the coolant, congealed into a gooey, slimy grey mess that clogged up the system, cause it to overheat, and finally blow a hose. Anyway, our mechanic has replaced the oil cooler, and filled the cooling system with water and Dawn dishwashing liquid.

Dish detergent to clean oil sludge out of the cooling system?

Step 3. Unscrew an oil cooler line from the radiator using the line wrench. This will spill out some oil, so you may want to keep the drain pan handy. Follow the oil line to the oil filter, and unbolt the bracket that holds the oil lines to the engine using the 3/8-inch ratchet and socket.

Step 1: Locate Oil Cooler Hose. Before you start to disconnect any lines or hoses, you must make sure you know where they are. Follow the oil cooler hose from the transmission or the oil pan, and trace its route to the radiator. You may find just a single line or a dual line, depending on the type of vehicle you own.

Engine Oil Cooler Remove & Install Engine Oil Cooler

Within the adapter is a gasket or rubber o-ring. If the oil cooler adapter fails externally, engine oil may be forced out of the engine. If the leak is small, you may notice a puddle of engine oil on the ground underneath your vehicle or quite possibly a stream of oil on the ground behind your vehicle.

Remove cooler line from transmission fitting. Pull the line out of the transmission fitting, taking care not to bend the line. The line is usually made of steel, ranging in width from 5/16-inch to 3/8-inch with a flare nut on the end.

How to Remove Transmission Cooler Lines Without a Quick ...

Do not use something forceful like a pressure washer or compressed air to clean the M8 Harley oil cooler. The excessive pressure can bend or warp the cooler's fins. The best way to clean the oil cooler body is with soap & water and a soft nylon brush. Inspect or clean the Harley oil cooler at every service or even as part of a pre-ride ...
