More Tips for Book References in APA Format Remember that your reference page needs to be double-spaced. The first line of each reference should be flush left with the margin of the page. If a digital object identifier (DOI) is available, include it at the end of the reference.

How to Cite a Textbook in APA - Using APA Style to Cite an Authored Textbook Put the author's or editor's name first. Include the publication year. Add the title of the textbook. Include the edition of the book next. End with the publisher's location and the publisher's name.

In-text references should immediately follow the title, word, or phrase to which they are directly relevant, rather than appearing at the end of long clauses or sentences. In-text references should always precede punctuation marks.

In-Text Citation

(Quotation) - entry that appears in the body of your paper after a direct quote.

References - entry that appears at the end of your paper.
